



CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE

1. Carriage hereunder is subject to the rules and limitations of the "Swiss Regulations of Carriage by Air" of October 3, 1952 (in the version of June 1, 1962) respectively, if applicable, to the "Warsaw Convention" dated October 12, 1929 or the "Warsaw Convention as amended at the Hague" of September 28, 1955. Please note that the liability of the Carrier for death or injury of the Passenger and/or loss or damage of luggage is - as a rule - limited.
2. The Passengers of most of the aircraft used are covered by a Passenger Accident Insurance. It is understood that any sum paid by Passenger Accident Insurance will be deducted and taken into account from any liability claim against the Carrier.
3. Carrier undertakes to use its best efforts to carry the Passengers and their baggage with reasonable dispatch. Departure, landing and flight times shown in the Flight Confirmation or elsewhere are however not guaranteed and form no part of this contract. Carrier may without notice substitute alternate Carriers and/or aircraft and may alter or omit stopping places shown on the ticket in case of necessity. Schedules are subject to change without notice. Carrier assumes no responsibility for making connections. Reserved are, if applicable, mandatory rules of Swiss or international Law to the extent they provide for more extended liability.
4. Any exclusion or limitation of liability of Carrier shall apply to and be for the benefit of agents, servants and representatives of Carrier and any person whose aircraft is used by the Carrier for carriage and its agents, servants and representatives.
5. For safety reasons the following articles/materials are not allowed to be carried in passenger baggage:
Brief-/security type attaché cases with alarm devices or incorporative lithium batteries and/or pyrotechnic material; explosives, munitions, fireworks and flares; gases (flammable, non-flammable, refrigerated and poisonous); flammable liquids such as lighter fuel, paints and thinner; easily igniting material, substances liable to spontaneous combustion or on contact with water emit flammable gases; electronic cigarettes; oxidising substances; poisonous and infectious substances; drugs; radioactive materials; corrosives such as mercury; Magnetised material and miscellaneous goods as listed in the IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations. Exempted are medicines, medical appliances, toiletries, smoking utensils (except gasoline cigarette lighters) and alcoholic drinks if carried in small quantities for personal use. If you have any questions or special goods to transport, please contact us.
6. No agent, servant or representative of Carrier has authority to alter, modify or waive any provisions of this contract.
7. This contract is governed and construed by Swiss Law. Reserved are, if applicable, mandatory rules of a foreign national Law or international treaties. Any possible invalidity of one or several provisions of these Conditions of Carriage shall not affect the validity of the remaining Terms.
